

HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT POLICY

DEFINITION

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is defined in the Personal Protective Equipment at Work which is intended to be worn or held by a person who is at work and which protects him or her against one or more risks to his or her health and safety'. This policy does not apply to ordinary working clothes and uniforms which do not specifically protect the health and safety of the wearer.

Personal Protective Equipment: includes items such as the following when they are worn for purposes of health and safety:

- gloves
- safety shoes
- helmet
- safety belt
- anchoring arms
- high visibility waistcoats
- eye protection

RESPONSIBILITIES OF HEADS OF DEPARTMENT AND PROJECT INCHARGE

- To ensure suitable and appropriate PPE is provided
- To carry out the assessment on the suitability of the PPE
- To maintain and replace PPE as necessary
- To provide adequate and suitable storage for all PPE
- To provide information, training and instruction.

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
