

EMERGENCY RESPONSE PROCEDURE

An emergency occurring at any installation can lead to injury, loss of life or damage to property along with impact on the environment. This may be within the installation or may be both inside and outside of it. The reason for development of such an emergency may be due to abnormal functioning of the devices within the installation or caused by third party or by natural factors. If the emergency becomes uncontrollable and may lead to damage to life and property in the premises and its neighborhood, it may be defined as a "disaster".

OBJECTIVES OF THE EMERGENCY RESPONSE PROCEDURE

- 1. To control, localize and eliminate the hazards in minimum time.
- 2. To minimize damage to property and environment.
- 3. To render medical treatment to the injured quickly
- 4. To speed up the rescue and head count operation
- 5. To safeguard others by timely evacuation
- 6. To ensure safety of the installation and persons before they re-enter and resume the work.
- 7. To restore normalcy as quickly as possible
