

ROAD SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Road Safety Key points

- Always drive or ride on the left side of the road.
- It is your responsibility to give way to emergency services vehicles such as fire engines and ambulances.
- Always use indicators to let other road users know about the planned change in the direction of travel.
- Always drive only in the permissible direction on a one-way road.
- Always stop your vehicle behind the stop lines.
- No vehicles should be towed closer to other vehicles on the road.
- Traffic Lights and Signs should be always obeyed.
- Always keep a safe distance from the vehicle in front of you.
- You should always have a clear view of the road ahead.
- Overloading a vehicle is not only dangerous but even illegal.
- Never ever drive under the influence of alcohol or any sort of intoxicating substance.
- Avoid distractions (avoid taking phone calls while driving).
- Do not cross the speed limits.

Common Checks for both Two / Four Wheelers:

1	Ensure you are holding Valid Driving License with valid due date.
2	Ensure you are having Vehicle Insurance policy, within due date.
3	Ensure you are holding copy of Vehicle Registration Certificate.
4	Ensure you are having Pollution control certificate, with in due date.
5	Ensure both left and right vehicle mirrors are properly positioned and firmly fitted.
6	Ensure Head Lamps, tail lamps, indicators, control switches etc., are in working condition.
7	Ensure Horn is in working condition and Tyre is in good condition.
8	Ensure First aid kit is available, with medicines and band aid.

For Two Wheelers:

1	Wearing Helmet with locking chin strap is mandatory.
2	Recommended Helmet with ISI mark.
3	Before starting, please ensure the Brake condition, Engine oil & Fuel level.
4	Periodic Service done for every 3000KMs or every 3Months whichever applicable.

For 4 Wheelers:

1	Wearing Safety Seat belt is mandatory.
2	Before starting, please ensure the Brake condition, Engine oil & Fuel level.
3	Ensure Windshield wiper is in working condition and availability of left, right and internal mirrors.
4	Ensure Spare Wheel availability and its condition.
6	Periodic Service done for every 5000 to 10000KMs or every 6Months whichever applicable.
