Power Tools Checklist - Feb 2023

Sr No	Short Text	Result
1	Inspect tools for any damage before and after each use.	Checked
2	Check body casing and vents for cracks or other damage.	Checked
3	If the tool has auxiliary or double handles, check to see that they installed securely.	Checked
4	Check for damaged switches and ones with faulty trigger locks.	Checked
5	Ensure that you have been properly trained to use the tool safely. Operate the tool according to the manufacturer's instructions.	Checked
6	Ensure that the power tool has the correct guard, shield or other attachment that the manufacturer recommends.	Checked
7	Switch off the tools before connecting them to a power supply.	Checked
