## HAZARD IDENTIFICATION AND MANAGEMENT

- Collect and reviews information about the hazard present or likely to be present in the workplace.
- Conduct initial and periodic workplace inspection of the workplace to identify new or recurring hazards.
- Investigate injuries, illnesses, incidents and close call/ near misses to determine the underlying hazards, their causes, and safety and health program shortcomings.
- Group similar incidents and identify trends in injuries, illnesses and hazard reported.
- Consider hazard associated with emergency or no routine solutions.
- Determine the severity and likelihood of incident that could result for each hazard identified and use this information to prioritize corrective action.
